#### Understanding High School Math Concepts

The goal for this course will focus on increasing high school level calculation skills and problem solving skills. Students will be guided to think mathematically as they prepare for End of Course Exams in high school math classes and the PERT. Math simulations will be used to demonstrate how math concepts are applied as students encounter real world situations; setting up a business, designing a budget for college life, planning an over-seas trip, realizing the impact that one poor grade can have on a GPA, realizing that memorizing math algorithms is only a small part of the skills needed to do well on EOCs, SATs, and the PERT. When math becomes real through understanding, application becomes easier.

A rising 7<sup>th</sup> grade student could take this course if they are preparing for high school level Algebra or Geometry as an 8<sup>th</sup> grade student. Pre-testing would be required or proof of enrollment in a high school level course.
