In an attempt to cure those suffering with Yellow Fever the first AC was invented in Port St. Joe. By 1844 a hurricane decimated what was left of the town that was once a boomtown. There is a myth that the Native Americans put a curse on the town that lead to the distruction. We will also visit the WW II museum in Carabelle. Students will stay in hotels or a nice beach house.
